1. Availability of Application Form

The Admission Application Form is available online at application.iilm.edu

The Cost of the Admission Form is Rs 1,100/- (All Courses less Engineering Courses) and Rs 600/- for Engineering Courses and are Non- Refundable. You can download it from the link.

2. Selection of the Program

3. Filling up of the Application Form and Important Instructions

The instructions in the Application Form are self-explanatory. PLEASE READ THE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE FILLING THE APPLICATION FORM.

Fill in the Application Form only if you meet the eligibility criteria for admission to the program.

Upload all the relevant educational documents as per the course selected and latest passport size photograph with the Application Form.

Foreign students / Foreign University Degree holder are required to attach photocopies of academic transcripts & AIU Equivalence Certificate.

Incorrect & incomplete forms will be rejected.

It is mandatory to provide correct and valid email address and mobile number in the form as it will be used by the Admission Office for all kinds of communication related to your admission.

If the applicant has appeared in a qualifying examination and the result thereof is awaited, the applicant can go through the selection process. However, it will be at his/her own risk if qualifying exam documents are not submitted by the stipulated date.

University / Board Marks filled in the Application Form will be considered for all purposes related to admission. Any discrepancy found during original document verification will result in cancellation of Admission.

The form will be processed in 2 to 3 working days after confirmation of receipt of Application Form on the admission link.

It is advised to keep a copy of the complete application form.

It may be noted that no request for change in the particulars filled in the Application after the applicant appears in the selection process will be entertained.

Cost of the Admission Form will not be refunded under any circumstances.

4. Information on Admission Portal

- Update on the Registration Status of the Application Form
- Whether the Application has been short-listed for the Selection Process
- Update on Online Selection Process (Link for video upload/re-upload OR link to appear in the online interview; whichever is applicable to the applicant)
- Copy of Admission Letter (It is recommended to take the printout of the Admission offer letter for record). The Admission Letter contains host of valuable information. Therefore, students are advised to go through the same meticulously and take action accordingly
- Fee payment options links
- Fee Receipt Confirmation Status

It is the responsibility of the student to keep a regular check of Admission status or all updates. Please keep a regular track of E-mails and SMS sent by the Admission Office. No separate communication will be sent through post/ telephonic calls with respect to Admission related information.

5. Offer of Admission

The information with respect to selection will be communicated to the student via Email.

All selected candidates will get an Admission offer via email. The Admission Letter contains valuable information regarding date of the payment of Fees of all Semesters, Commencement Date, Time, Venue of the Program, Allotment of Hostel (If applied), Scholarship (If any) and the Documents required at the time of joining. Hence, the Admission aspirants are advised to go through the same carefully and take action as mentioned therein.

Offer of admission will be provisional and valid for the current Academic year only. The admission offer will automatically stand cancelled if the eligibility and terms & conditions are not fulfilled within the specific time mentioned in the Admission Letter.

Failure to pay the fee by due date or report to the institution for classes after the specified date mentioned in the Admission Letter will entail in cancellation of admission.

It is mandatory for all students to submit medical insurance at the time of registration.

6. Admission of Foreign Applicants

(Kindly refer to Annexure II of the Admission Handbook 2023-2024)

Eligibility criteria remains same for Foreign applicants as applicable for Indian resident applicants. Last date for the acceptance of Form for Foreign Nationals: 30th Jul 2023.

Mandatory Criteria for Admission to Undergraduate (UG) Programs:

- It is mandatory for any foreign applicant to have completed equivalent to 12 years of formal schooling and he/she must meet the minimum eligibility criteria as prescribed in the Admission Prospectus.
- In absence of English subject, candidates should have cleared TOEFL with score of 60 out of 120 in IBT or a band of 6.5 in IELTS.
- Academic transcripts must be translated in certified English language listing all the courses with grades or marks earned. Transcripts in languages other than English will not be accepted.

Mandatory requirements for Admission to Post Graduate (PG) Programs:

- It is mandatory for any foreign applicant to have completed equivalent to 12 years of formal education at the school level followed by a bachelor's degree of minimum 3 years duration.
- It is essential to meet the eligibility criteria as prescribed in the admission prospectus.
- In absence of English subject, candidates should have cleared TOEFL with score of 60 out of 120 in IBT or a band of 6.5 in IELTS.

Essential Requirement: AIU Equivalence Certificate

- Every Foreign Degree / Diploma / Certificate holder must obtain AIU equivalence certificate.
- Equivalence certificate can be obtained from Association of Indian Universities (AIU). Applicant can apply online to AIU.

Following are the documents required by AIU to obtain AIU Equivalence Certificate:

1. Degree/Diploma/Certificate along with the year-wise Academic Transcript duly authenticated by the Indian Embassy in the Country or its concerned Foreign Mission in India.
2. Accreditation status of the University/Institute which the student has last attended.
3. Copies of the academic Certificates from Higher Secondary onwards (wherever necessary)

The SERVICE CHARGE for issue of Equivalence Certificate as applicable is payable through Demand Draft in favor of "Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi".

The onus of obtaining AIU Equivalence Certificate is on the candidate and application will be considered only after the Equivalence Certificate is submitted.

The student has to take medical Insurance of Rs 3 Lakh on arrival through campus.

The student should have a valid passport and obtained student VISA from Indian Embassy.

7. Admission through Lateral Entry

IILM offers admission through Lateral entry up to 4th semester depending on the duration of offered programs. For details, please contact Admission cell.

8. Ph.D. Admission

IILM University offers admission to Ph.D. Programs in various disciplines / research areas on Full time and Part time mode. Intake for Ph.D, admission starts in Jan and session starts in July. For details, please contact Admission cell.

9. Withdrawal Procedure

Withdrawal applications are required to be initiated through respective mentors/Admission cell. Refund shall be processed as per university guide lines at the time of withdrawal.

10. Anti-Ragging Measures

Ragging is totally banned in IILM University campus including its departments, all its premises (academic, residential, sports, canteen etc.) whether located within the campus or outside and in all means of transportation of students whether public or private, and anyone found guilty of ragging and/or abetting ragging is liable to be punished appropriately. The University has constituted an Anti-Ragging Committee for prompt disposal of such cases, if any.

All students and parents are required to submit an Affidavit as per the format shared by AICTE. It is mandatory to register the affidavit on the AICTE website and mention the registration noon the application form.

11. Hostel Facility

AC hostel accommodation is available within the campus for girls and out campus for boys. Interested candidates can apply for Hostel Accommodation by mentioning in the Application Form or by posting query to Admission Office.

IILM UNIVERSITY – POLICY FOR ADMISSION FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS**ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS**

Fifteen percent seats in all the programmes of the University shall be allowed to be filled on supernumerary basis over and above the approved intake from amongst Foreign Nationals/Persons of Indian Origin/Foreign Students. These seats are provided by the MHRD under the PIHEAD (Promotion of Indian Higher Education Abroad) programme. Under no circumstances, a seat remaining unfilled shall be allocated to anyone other than a Foreign Student/PIO/Foreign National.

FEE STRUCTURE

The proposed fee for foreign students for the session 2023- 2024 as given in the prospectus. The prescribed fee will be collected in US\$ or Indian rupees.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility qualifications for international students will be the same as for Indian students for each programme. For detailed information log on to our website (www.iilm.edu)

VISA

Should have valid passport and student VISA. The visa can be obtained from the Indian missions abroad by producing admission letter signed by the Registrar of the University. Visit website <https://indianfrro.gov.in/eservices/home.jsp>

EMPLOYMENT

As per visa restriction, International students should not count on obtaining work in India for covering their expenses while studying. In fact part-time employment during the academic session is almost impossible to find. Students coming to India should have enough money to cover all the expenses.

RESIDENCE AND EXPENSES

The University provides limited accommodation on the campus.

HEALTH CARE

The student has to take medical Insurance of Rs 3 Lakh on arrival through campus

DISCIPLINE

The International students should abide by all the rules of University and the Code of Conduct as applicable to Indian students. No foreign student can leave campus without prior permission from the competent authority.

REGISTRATION WITH FRRO, POLICE

Upon arrival in India every foreign student must be registered with the Police/FRRO within fourteen days from the date of first entry into India. The FRRO can impose heavy fines if this registration is delayed or not done.

CERTIFICATES AND DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO BE SUBMITTED BY CANDIDATES ALONG WITH APPLICATION FORM FOR ADMISSION TO VARIOUS PROGRAMMES OF STUDY

- i. Filled-in Application Form.
- ii. Proof of date of birth.
- iii. Certificate and mark sheet of the qualifying examination issued by the Board/University. In cases, where the University has prescribed a condition of passing a subject or subjects at some level, the Certificate/Mark sheet for the concerned examination in proof thereof should also be produced (original and one photocopy of certificates are required).
- iv. All the relevant information/documents, which may justify the equivalence of their qualifications from the concerned competent authority— Association of Indian University (AIU).
- v. Mark-sheets/Degrees in a language other than English should be got translated into English language and candidates should attach a duly attested copy of the same.
- vi. Conduct and Character Certificate from the Head of the Institution from where the qualifying examination has been passed or from concerned Embassy.
- vii. Certificate of Medical Fitness to be signed by a Registered Medical Practitioner holding a degree not lower than MBBS
- viii. Student Visa & Passport.

CONTINUATION OF ON ADMISSION SCHOLARSHIPS

- ② Scholarships are awarded on an annual basis, and eligibility for subsequent years of the program is contingent upon adherence to the scholarship policy.
- ② To continue benefiting from a 100% scholarship, students are required to attain a position within the top 5% of the merit list for their program, maintaining a minimum CGPA of 9 or higher. For those seeking to maintain a 40% or 50% scholarship, they must secure a spot in the top 10% of the merit list for their program and sustain a minimum CGPA of 8.5 or higher.
- ② To maintain a scholarship ranging from 10% to 30%, students are required to consistently rank within the top 15% of the merit list and maintain a minimum CGPA of 8 or higher.
- ② To retain their scholarship eligibility, students must maintain an attendance rate exceeding 75% in each semester and should not face any academic or disciplinary restrictions during their course of study.
- ② For sports scholarships, the continuation into the second year will depend on the student's active participation in university sports activities where they represent the institution at national or international level.

IMPORTANT SCHOLARSHIP NOTES

- ② Students are not eligible to receive a combination of scholarships and concessions. Only one type of Scholarship/Concession may be availed, and you will receive the one that offers the greater benefit.
- ② For scholarship applications to be considered, it is imperative that they are accompanied by complete details in the prescribed format and the necessary Sports/Martyr Certificates/Documents. Incomplete applications will not be processed and will be canceled.
- ② It's important to note that scholarships in any category do not cover the costs of boarding and lodging.
- ② In all scholarship categories, students are initially required to pay the full fees. Any excess amount resulting from the scholarship will be adjusted against the payment for Semester-II.
- ② The grant of scholarships is subject to the approval of the Scholarship Committee.
- ② It's important to be aware that a limited number of scholarship seats are available, and they are granted on a first-come, first-served basis. Early application is encouraged.
- ② The deadline for applying for scholarships for all programs is August 31, 2024. Please ensure that your application is submitted by this date to be considered for a scholarship.
