IILM University Gurugram-Institute Innovation Council (IIC-IILMU)

In the year 2018, the Ministry of Education (MOE) launched the Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) program in collaboration with AICTE for Higher Educational Institutions (HEI) tosystematicallyfosterthecultureofinnovationandstartupecosystemineducationinstitutions.

Institution Innovation Council of IILM University, Gurugram. The IIC envisions creating an innovation ecosystem at a national level. IIC helps students to have their start-ups before graduating from college. This turns the students from job-seekers to employment generators. There are about 2711 established institutes having incubation centers. Students who have an innovative idea have a golden opportunity to take guidance from the e-cells in their colleges. IIC also prepares colleges for Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements Framework (ARIIA). Primarily, IIC's role is to engage a large number of faculty, students and staff in various innovation and entrepreneurship related activities such as IPR, problem-solving, management at pre-incubation/incubation stage etc.

The recent achievement of India's 40th rank out of 132 countries for year 2023, in the Global Innovation Index (GII) is a reflection of the same. IIC focuses on helping students with pre-incubation ideas. The primary mandate of MIC is to encourage, inspire and nurture young students by supporting them to work with new ideas and transform them into prototypes while they are in formative years.

















